The meeting commenced at 7.00pm Cllr Munday welcomed everyone to the meeting. A risk assessment had been carried out for 9 Councillors and up to 24-28 members of the public with seating 1 metre apart.

- 1. <u>To Record Apologies for Absence</u> Cllr K Spicer
- 2. <u>To approve minutes of the meeting held on Thursday 4 November 2021</u> The minutes were approved as a true record and duly signed.

- 3. Matters arising from the minutes. No matters arising all covered by Agenda items.
- 4. <u>Drainage of Parish Field on pitch & Field Access Update -</u> The deep aeration treatment seems to be working. Maritime FC are improving the access to the school field with £3½K from Gordon Jones' Locality Budget Billy Richmond supplied the hardcore free of charge and the work is still ongoing. This will be a benefit for the community.
- 5. Equipment on Field Update Three quotes have been obtained for the gym equipment still waiting to hear from Babergh re the CIL funding as soon as this is received we can put the order in. A discussion followed on the rubber mulch surface at a cost of £5,470 from Sunshine Gyms and grass matting (fire resistant) from Caloo at £2,024.75. Awaiting quote from Action Play and Leisure for grass matting. It was finally proposed that on receipt of the quote from Action Play and Leisure the Parish Council give the Clerk authority to place the order for the equipment and grass matting once the CIL money is received from Babergh.

6. <u>Firework Accounts - </u> Councillors had been issued with 9 month accounts figures which showed a balance in the Fun Day Tracker account of £4,396.69 this figure included the Fireworks monies banked explained by the Clerk and set out in the table below.
