- **To discuss Purchase of Maritime Units -** The Clerk read out e-mail from Jon Haines the two units including fixtures and fittings were top of the range and cost around £10,500. He would much prefer the Parish to have them and would be prepared to take £2,000 to £2,500 that includes the internal serving counter, gas boiler/urn and solar/usb unit. After some discussion it was proposed that the container be purchased for £2,500 with a letter of thanks to Jon.

5. <u>To discuss Grounds Maintenance</u> – Two quotes had been obtained - **Ed Seeley** - The price to clear the brambles by the side of 28 West Mill Green and strim the area will be £480. The price to strim the area around the gate by West Mill Green will be £80. The quote per cut for regular fortnightly cutting of the play area is £60, the gym area £50, the school playing field £120, and the village green £250. I would aim to make around 16 fortnightly cuts per year **Vertas** the cost to cut both fields 14 times a year is £1,200 + Vat. The cost to cut the play area 17 times a year is £510 + Vat. Councillors proposed that Ed Seeley be asked to clear brambles and strim gate by West Mill Green and that they accept Vertas quote for both fields and play area.
